1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.150 dated 04.09.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 341, 307, 379-B, 427, 506, 201 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station BPTP, Faridabad.
2. Vide order dated 13.12.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 13.12.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Mukesh Kumar, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.



5. Learned counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 13.12.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) BNSS.

7. Petition stands allowed.
