1. On 05.02.2025, this Court had passed the hereinafter reproduced order upon the instant writ petition:-

*“The main grievance which propelled the present petitioner to approach this Court by casting instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is the indolent and lackadaisical approach of the authority concerned, in not deciding his legal notice dated 13.06.2023 (Annexure P-16).*

*Notice of motion.*

*Mr.Pardeep Bajaj, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents, and waives service.*

*He seeks time to file a written statement to the instant petition.*

*Adjourned to 26.03.2025.*

*The respondent no.3, is directed to make its all endeavours to take final decision on the legal notice (Annexure P-16), within a period of 20 days from today, and a copy of the decision, so taken, shall be placed on record, positively, on or before the next*

*date of hearing.*

*In case the compliance of the aforesaid direction is not made, respondent no.3, shall cause his personal appearance before this Court, on the next date of hearing.*

*To be shown in the urgent list.*

*It is made clear that no further request for an adjournment shall be entertained on the next date of hearing, on behalf of either of the parties.”*

2. In deference to the directions (supra) issued by this Court, today the learned State counsel has placed on record the copy of Order/Memo No.3360 dated 24.03.2025, copy whereof is also supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner. This order/memo speaks that, a major part of the admitted payment has already been paid to the petitioner and only a minor part thereof remains to be paid.

3. Moreover, the learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by the author of the order/memo (supra), namely, Dharminder Singh, Executive Engineer, W/S & Sanitation Division, Fazilka, has informed this Court that, the requisite amount will be released in favour of the petitioner within a month from today.

4. In view of the above, no further direction is required to be passed. Consequently, the instant writ petition is closed. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to, in case his grievance still survives, take recourse to the statutory remedy(ies).
