Learned counsel for the parties submit that the matter has been amicably settled. Pursuant to the same, a demand draft bearing No.005380 140240202 999990 16 dated 28.01.2025 for a sum of ₹2,50,000/- drawn on HDFC Bank in favour of the respondent has been handed over by learned counsel representing the appellant to learned counsel representing the respondent in Court. A copy of the same has been retained on the record.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent has also submitted a communication dated 20.01.2025 issued by the respondent authorities authorizing learned counsel to make a statement on behalf of the respondent and to accept the decretal amount.

3. Learned counsel for the appellants submits that in view of the compromise having been arrived at between the parties, he may be permitted to withdraw the present appeal. Learned counsel for the respondent also submits that since the decree stands satisfied, no further action shall be

initiated pursuant to the said decree against the appellant as mentioned in the communication dated 20.01.2025.

In view of the above, the present Regular Second Appeal is dismissed as having been withdrawn.
