1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.195, dated 28.05.2023, registered under Sections 406,420,120-B of IPC, Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 03.02.2025 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. A status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, H.Q. District Rewari has been filed on behalf of respondent-State and the same is taken on record. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
