In the present writ petition, the petitioner prays for directions to the respondents to release him the retiral benefits i.e. gratuity, regular pension, interest on delayed payment of earned leave, interest on delayed payment of GIS payment and other remaining benefits which has been withheld arbitrary.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction be given to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 09.06.2025 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioner in a time-bound manner.
