**Main case.**

1. Petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in

FIR No.73 dated 31.07.2024 under Sections 406/498-A/323 IPC registered at Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) in which petitioner was granted interim bail vide order dated 20.12.2024.

2. Today, learned counsel for petitioner has also placed on record copy of compromise (Annexure P-3). It is matter of record that petition filed by petitioner and others for quashing of aforesaid FIR in CRM-M-64556-2024 is also fixed for today and the said petition has been allowed vide my separate order and the aforesaid FIR regarding present petitioner and other co-accused has been quashed.

3. Since, the aforesaid *FIR No.73 (supra)* has already been quashed in CRM-M-64556-2024 today itself, the instant petition for grant of anticipatory bail has rendered infructuous and disposed of accordingly.

4. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
