**NAMIT KUMAR, J.**

1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for direction to decide criminal complaint No.COMI/21/2023 – “Kailash v. Vinod Kumar and others” of the petitioner at the earliest.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced copies of orders dated 16.12.2024, 09.01.2025 and 15.01.2025, passed by learned SDJM, Tohana. Perusal of order dated 16.12.2024 shows that arguments on the point of summoning of accused were not advanced and adjournment was sought by learned counsel for the complainant and the case was adjourned to 21.12.2024. Order dated 21.12.2024 has not been produced, however, it appears that the matter was thereafter adjourned for 09.01.2025. On 09.01.2025, an application seeking exemption from personal appearance of the complainant was filed and



arguments on the point of summoning of accused were not advanced and adjournment was sought, which was granted for 15.01.2025. On 15.01.2025 also the arguments on the point of summoning of accused were not advanced and adjournment was sought and granted. Now the complaint is pending for 28.01.2025, for abovesaid purpose. In this view of the matter, no direction, as has been sought in the present petition, can be issued once the adjournments are being sought on behalf of the complainant/petitioner.
