**KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)**

1. Through the instant writ petition, challenge is thrown to the order dated 22.12.2017 (Annexure P-2), and also the order dated 03.01.2018 (Annexure P-3), passed by respondent No.2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the entire assessed amount has already been deposited, therefore, nothing substantive survives for adjudication in the instant writ petition.

3. On the other hand, learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that, initially the entire assessed amount had been recovered. However, a Coordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 15.01.2018, directed the petitioner to deposit 75% of the amount, within period of eight weeks. In pursuance thereof, the petitioner approached respondent No.3, and accordingly, 25% of the amount was returned to it on 16.02.2018, which is yet to be recovered.



4. The relevant part of the order (supra), is extracted hereinbelow:-

***“Operation of orders dated 22.12.2017 (Annexure P2) and 03.01.2018 (Annexure P3) are stayed subject to payment of 75% by the petitioner in the respondent department with reference to Annexures P2 and P3. Petitioner is hereby directed to deposit 75% of demand within a period of 8 weeks from today. If the petition is allowed in that event petitioner is entitled to interest @ 6% per annum on the deposited money of 75%.*”**

5. Since the petitioner itself does not intend to press the instant writ petition any further, the same is **disposed of**. However, in case the entire amount is not recovered, respondent No.3 is at liberty to recover the remaining amount.
