1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.77, dated 02.05.2025, under Section(s) 118(1), 115(2), 191(3), 190, 303(2) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Maqboolpura, District Amritsar.

2. It is noticed that vide order dated 24.07.2025, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar (Annexure P-3), petitioner was granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail with a direction to join the investigation.

However, despite being afforded several opportunities, petitioner failed to comply with the said direction and did not join the investigation. Thereafter, as a second attempt, petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present petition seeking anticipatory bail.

3. Such a prayer, in the form of a second petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), is not maintainable.

If the petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated 24.07.2025, appropriate remedy available in law, has not been availed by him. Accordingly, present petition stands **dismissed** as not maintainable.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to challenge the said order dated 24.07.2025 (Annexure P-3), in accordance with law.
