These petitions have been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant minimum of pay scale admissible to the Assistant Professors to the petitioners, who are working as contractual Guest Teachers in Government Colleges, in terms of the judgment dated 30.04.2024, rendered in LPA No.733 of 2024 titled *State of Haryana and others v. Kalyan Singh and others*.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that only petitioners no.3 and 8 in CWP No.4588 of 2025 have been given the benefit following the law laid down in *Kalyan Singh* case *ibid*, and for no reason the benefit has not been given to the remaining petitioners.



3. Learned State counsel, on instructions, contends that only on account of unintentional procedural delays, the benefit could not be given to the remaining petitioners, which will now be released by the second respondent within four weeks.
4. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petitions being disposed of in terms thereof.
5. Ordered accordingly.
6. In case the due benefit is not released within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
