1. Present petition has been filed praying for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to transfer the investigation of case bearing FIR No.0081, dated 13.02.2023, under Sections 406, 420 & 120-B of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Jagadhri City, Haryana (Annexure P-1) to some independent Agency or from some senior police officials as the petitioners are not expecting fair and impartial investigation at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 who in connivance with accused persons are tampering the investigation of the present case. Further prayer has been made for calling the status report of FIR No.0081, dated 13.02.2023, under Sections 406, 420 & 120-B of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Jagadhri City, Haryana (Annexure P-1).



2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are the parents of Brahm Dev, who had taken the loan of Rs.16 lacs from the bank. He has submitted that the petitioners never gave their consent for the loan, however their son had taken the loan without their consent in collusion with the bank officials. He has submitted that FIR was lodged and no investigation is being conducted in the same.

3. Reply dated 29.01.2025 by way of an affidavit of Rajesh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar on behalf of the respondents has been filed by learned State counsel today in the Court and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions has submitted that the investigation is already going on, however till date the accused could not be arrested.

5. In view of the above position, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the Investigating Agencies to carry out the fair and impartial investigation and conclude the same expeditiously in accordance with law preferably within a period of three months from today.
