Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 14.7.2023 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Rohtak in case bearing No.CS-1100-2022 titled as “Dr. Kulbir Jakhar vs. Jitendra Ranga etc.” whereby defence of the petitioner has been struck off as despite granting numerous opportunities and the fact that the petitioners/defendants have been appearing since 08.2.2023, reply had not been filed.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the counsel representing the petitioners before the learned trial Court had merely been informing the petitioners on various dates being granted by the learned trial Court, however, had not informed the petitioners that written statement was required to be filed. However, on Court query, learned counsel for the petitioners admits that the petitioners are not uneducated persons; also admits that orders of the



learned trial Court are regularly updated on the website; and further gives no reason as to why order dated 14.7.2023 is being challenged in April 2025. It is further admitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the plaintiff's evidence has been concluded before the learned trial Court.

In view of the above facts, no ground is made out for interfering in the order dated 14.7.2023 passed by the learned trial Court.

The present petition stands **dismissed**.
