1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 24.08.2020, in CWP-12609-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 24.08.2020, reveals that CWP-12609-2020, was disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioners to file a detailed comprehensive legal notice as regard their claim within three weeks from the date of order and in the eventuality of any such legal notice being served, the respondent authorities were obligated to examine the same and pass a detailed speaking order thereupon within six weeks from the date of submission of legal notice and in case the petitioners were found entitled to the claim, benefits in respect thereto were to be paid to them without any further delay.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that needful has been done in compliance of order Annexure P/1 dated 24.08.2020, in CWP-12609-2020 and benefits as per entitlement have already been released to the petitioners and that in the circumstances, the petitioners

are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971,
