1. Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members with a further prayer to direct the official respondents to take appropriate legal action against the private respondents in cross-case GD No.13 dated 31.07.2025 under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 191(3) & 190 of BNS, 2023 in FIR No.0050 dated 04.06.2025 under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 191(3), 190 & 333 of BNS, 2023 (Sections 118(2) & 238 of BNS, 2023, added later on) at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar Rural.

2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is facing prosecution in in FIR No.0050 dated 04.06.2025, whereas on behest of the petitioner a cross case bearing GD No.13 dated 31.07.2025 has been registered. He submits that a representation dated 06.09.2025 (Annexure P-6) has been filed for the redressal of her grievance, however, till date no action has been taken.



He has further submitted that petitioner would be satisfied if representation is decided in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only at this stage.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. J. S. Arora, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.
5. Heard.
6. After hearing counsel for the parties and in view of limited prayer made by the petitioner, respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar is directed to decide the representation dated 16.09.2025 (Annexure P-6) filed by the petitioner expeditiously, preferably within four weeks from today, in accordance with law. However, State would ensure the protection of the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members.
7. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
8. It is being clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioner for legal action for violation of the law, if any, committed by her.
