Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for not complying the interim order dated 14.2.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Division Bench of this Court in CWP-20384-2021 titled as “Pradeep Kumar vs. State of Haryana and others” whereby the following direction was issued :-

“xxx xxx xxx

Keeping in view of above detailed proposed plan and the interest of the land owners, a direction is being given in this case that all the executing courts in the State of Haryana are restrained from taking any coercive steps as the



respondents have carved out plan for depositing the compensation amount and the reference courts will accept the compensation as per the above said proposed plan.

Learned counsel for respondent-HSVP further informs that due publication will be done with respect to proposed plan of depositing compensation in the entire State of Haryana so that land owners can be aware with respect to deposit of compensation as per the schedule stated above.

A direction is being given to the respondents to comply and make the payment in accordance with the above said proposed plan/priority list.

Status report dated 06.8.2025 on behalf of respondent No.3 by way of affidavit of Mrs. Anupma Malik, Land Acquisition Collector, Urban Estate, Gurugram; and Status report dated 08.09.2025 on behalf of respondent No.1 by way of affidavit of Shri Rakesh Saini, Estate Officer-I, HSVP, Gurugram have been filed. The same are taken on record. Copies thereof are supplied to the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. The Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place in the file.

Learned counsel for the respondents refers to Annexure R-1 annexed with their respective Status Reports and submit that the necessary compliance has been made; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the order dated 14.2.2022 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with, he may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition.

Permitted to do so.

The present contempt petition is **dismissed as withdrawn.**

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
