1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS, 2023, seeking quashing of impugned order dated 27.09.2024 (Annexure P-6) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Panchkula in SC-49/2019 whereby the bail granted to the petitioner in case FIR No.522 dated 24.09.2017, registered at P. S. Sector-5, Panchkula, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 3(2) of the Haryana Protection of Interest of depositors in Financial Establishment Act, 2013, whereby the bail bonds as well as surety bonds of the petitioner have been cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued against him for 04.08.2025.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had gone to Hyderabad for some urgent business work due to which he could not appear before the trial Court on the date fixed. However, he had filed an application for exemption from his personal appearance. Hence, the impugned order deserves to be set aside. He further submits that the petitioner is willing to join the proceedings before the trial Court.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Tapan Masta, Addl. A. G. Haryana., accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the case file.
6. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, this Court deems it appropriate to decide this case without issuing notice to respondent No.2. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and limited prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any legitimate ground to interfere in the impugned order dated 27.09.2024 (Annexure P-6) passed by the learned Additional Session Judge, Panchkula. However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court at 10:00 am on 04.08.2025 and moves application for grant of regular bail, on his doing so, the trial Court shall consider and decide the same on the same day.
7. Petition stands dismissed.
