1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-Additional Chief Secretary, Town & Country Planning, Urban Estate Department, Haryana to take a final decision on the show cause notice dated 03.01.2024 (Annexure P-9) after considering the reply to the same filed by the petitioners through legal notice dated 23.12.2024 (Annexure P-12) in a time bound manner.

2. Learned State counsel, who appears on advance notice, has no objection if the above prayer is accepted.

3. In the light of above, we find that the afore prayer made on behalf of the petitioners is reasonable and also that learned State counsel has no objection to the acceptance thereof, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to take a final decision on the show cause notice dated 03.01.2024



(Annexure P-9) after considering the issues raised in the reply thereof by the petitioners through the legal notice dated 23.12.2024 (Annexure P-12), by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to all concerned, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioners and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioners, they would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
