NIDHI GUPTA J. (Oral)

Present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 29.5.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-30450-2025 titled as “Punit Arora vs. State of Punjab and others”, whereby the petition was disposed of as withdrawn with the following observations :-

“....Given above, present petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh representation before the Director General of Police, Punjab by 05.06.2025, If the petitioner files a precise representation within the above-mentioned time period, then, the same shall be decided by the concerned Director General of Police, by 27.06.2025 positively, either



himself/herself or by authorizing and delegating it to any officer of IPS Cadre. It is clarified that order so passed must be a reasoned order, and the same be communicated to the representationists as well as his counsel, without any delay on their e-mail mentioned on the representation. Liberty reserved to the petitioner to file fresh petition or to take other legal remedies in accordance with the law. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed.”

Learned counsel for the respondents has filed the Reply dated 11.10.2025 by way of affidavit of Shri Gaurav Yadav, IPS, Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is pointed out by learned counsel for the respondents-State that in compliance of the order dated 29.5.2025 (Annexure P-1) the representation of the petitioner has been decided by passing a Speaking Order dated 11.10.2025 (Annexure R-2). It is submitted that prior to passing of said Speaking Order an SIT was constituted by the respondent-State, which investigated the matter thoroughly, whereupon the said Speaking Order dated 11.10.2025 (Annexure R-2) has been passed recommending the Report of the SIT dated 25.9.2025 (Annexure R-1), whereby challan has been filed in the present case qua the original accused, namely, Bhagwan Dass and Manna Johar @ Shubham Kumar on 13.6.2025; and the other accused persons have been exonerated. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that therefore, now no cause survives in the present petition.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the order dated 29.5.2025 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with and Speaking Order dated 11.10.2025 (Annexure R-2) has been passed, the present contempt petition may be disposed of.

Heard.

In view of the facts noted above and the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, the present contempt petition is **disposed of** accordingly.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand(s) disposed of.
