The instant criminal revision petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging the impugned order dated 25.11.2019 passed by the learned Family Court, Faridabad whereby while allowing the petition filed by the respondent-wife under Section 125 Cr.P.C., a sum of Rs.4000/- per month has been awarded to her as maintenance from the date of filing of the petition till the date of order, along with litigation expenses of Rs.7000/-, and further in view of escalation of cost of living, Rs.4500/- per month in future till further orders towards maintenance.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that since the impugned order has already been complied with by the petitioner, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
