1. The present petition has been filed raising challenge to the order dated 25.04.2018 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Jalandhar, whereby, an application filed by the petitioner for setting aside *ex parte* order dated 14.08.2014 was allowed subject to payment of entire maintenance till date as awarded vide order dated 14.08.2014.

2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner in Court today and same has been the position from the last seven years.

3. Vide order dated 09.07.2018, the petitioner was directed to deposit half of the amount of maintenance as awarded vide order dated 14.08.2014 (Annexure P-3). The same was not complied with and one more opportunity was granted to the petitioner on 19.11.2018. Subsequently on 24.05.2022, the situation remain the same and one last opportunity was granted to the petitioner but the same was not complied with.

4. In the interest of justice, the Court had passed the order dated 02.09.2025, which reads as under:



*“There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner and same was the position on the last two dates of hearing also.*

*Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 19.11.2018 has not been complied with till date and prays that present petition be dismissed.*

*In the interest of justice, adjourned to 09.10.2025.*

*Let a copy of this order be sent to Mr. H.B.S. Baidwan, Advocate for the petitioner.”*

5. In compliance of order dated 02.09.2025 (supra), the office has reported that the copy of the above-said order was duly forwarded to the learned counsel for the petitioner- Mr. H.B.S. Baidwan, but despite the same, there is no representation on his behalf.

6. In light of the above, the present petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the petitioner to file it afresh, in case, any cogent cause of action survives.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
