Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that entire amount due towards the petitioner has been released in his favour, as such, he does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

However, with regard to claim of the petitioner towards delayed disbursement of interest, he would be at liberty to raise his claim by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from the release of payments, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent, the officer concerned would be liable to pay cost(s) of Rs.50,000/- to the petitioner from his/her own pocket.
