1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, she would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, District Jind to take a decision on the representation dated 02.01.2024 (Annexure P-4), submitted by the petitioner.
2. Learned State counsel, who appears on advance notice, has no objection if the above prayer is accepted.
3. Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 02.01.2024 (Annexure P-4), submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to all concerned, preferably within six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
4. Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, he would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
