This petition has been filed under Section Section 528 of BNSS with a prayer for issuing directions to the respondent No.3 and 4 to get conduct fair and impartial investigation/inquiry from the Crime Branch or agency for some other independent the murder of Amritpal Singh husband of the petitioner by the respondent No.8 and other co-accused persons namely Vikramjeet Singh and Lakhveer Singh as the accused have murdered the husband of the petitioner and have shown a roadside accident and the police has registered FIR No.0181 dated 05.07.2024 (P-2) u/s 106, 281 of BNS at Police Station City Ratia, District Fatehabad.

Status report dated 21.02.2025 by way of affidavit of Sanjay Kumar, HPS, DSP, Ratia, District Fatehabad has already been

filed. The relevant paragraph No. 10 is reproduced below:-

'That on completion of the investigation, final report u/s 193 BNSS has been prepared on 10.02.2025 for the offences u/s 281, 106 of BNS against one accused namely Jashanpreet Singh and same has been submitted in the Ld. Court on 17.02.2025. Investigating agency cited total 16 witnesses in the final report and the trial of the present case is pending in the court of Ld. SDJM Ratia and is fixed for 25.04.2025 for Appearance.'

A perusal of the same depict that final report under Section 193 BNSS has been prepared on 10.02.2025 and the same has been submitted before the Court on 17.02.2025 and the prosecution has cited total 16 witnesses in the final report and the case is now for 25.04.2025 for appearance.

In view of the above, this petition does not survive having no cause of action, hence, the same is disposed of as having rendered infructuous. Ordered accordingly.
