1. Present petition has been filed praying for directing the official respondents for conducting free and fair investigation in case DDR No.37, dated 05.11.2024, registered under Sections 115(2), 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, Police Station Bhogpur, Jalandhar Rural, Punjab (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner and further to mark enquiry to some senior officer not below the rank of Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural as no coercive measures have been adopted by the police authority against respondents No.6 & 7 till date and the police is acting at the behest of accused person, who is politically influential person despite a detailed representation (Annexure P-4) posted on 20.12.2024 has been submitted to respondent No.3 in which no action has been taken till date. Further prayer has been made for directing respondents No.1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents



No.6 & 7 and their accomplices, who are threatening and pressurizing the petitioner to compromise the matter.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner lodged the DDR bearing No.37, dated 05.11.2024, however no action has been taken on the same till date. He has further submitted that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has already filed his complaint/representation dated 20.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) before respondent No.3, but no action has been taken on the same till date.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5-State. He submits that complaint/representation filed by the petitioner dated 20.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) would be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.

5. In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural to look into the complaint/representation of the petitioner dated 20.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.
