Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that in terms of the order dated 04.10.2024 passed by the Local Authority-cum-Municipal Corporation, SAS Nagar Mohali, the petitioner shall move appropriate application for issuance of 'certificate of vending' and the same shall be considered in accordance with law within a period of one month from today as per the procedure laid down under the relevant rules.

2. In view of the above, learned counsel for petitioner submits that she does not want to press the present petition.

3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed.

4. Rule stands discharged.

5. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officers) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
