1. The appellant claims to be a third party objector. Her objection petition has been dismissed on account of the fact that her previous objection petition was dismissed on 14.01.2020.

2. Learned counsel representing the appellant submits that on the day the appellant filed first objection petition her suit '*Pushpa Devi vs. Ajmer Kaur and others*' was pending before the Court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kharar. He submits that in view of the Order 21 Rule 104 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, the decision in the objection petition is subject to the decision of the pending suit.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the execution second appeal is disposed of with the observations that the appellant, if so advised, may prosecute her pending suit.
