1. Present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying the order dated 11.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record a short reply alongwith Annexure R-1 dated 25.03.2025 to show that in pursuance of the order passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court on 11.11.2024, the representation of the petitioner has been considered and a speaking order has been passed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is not satisfied with the order dated 25.03.2025 and has submitted that the present contempt petition be disposed of but liberty be granted to the petitioner to challenge the order dated 25.03.2025.

4. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.

5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of with the abovesaid order.
