ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to provide protection to life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9, petitioners have come up before this Court by filing the present petition under Section 226 of Constitution of India.

2. Notices are served upon the official respondents through the State's counsel.
3. After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be contended and satisfied if petitioners are permitted to file fresh representation before the concerned Superintendent of Police, and if direction be issued to the Superintendent of Police to decide the same in time bound manner.
4. Counsel for the State has no objection if the above said prayer is accepted.
5. Given above, present petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to file fresh representation supported by notarized affidavit before the concerned Superintendent of Police, within 15 days from today. If the petitioner files a precise representation within the above-mentioned time period, then, the same shall be decided by the concerned Superintendent of Police, within two months from that day positively, either himself/herself or by authorizing and delegating it to any officer of IPS
