1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobedience of order dated 23.01.2024 passed by this court in CWP-1332-2024.

2. In compliance of order dated 23.01.2024, the counsel for respondent has placed on record copy of speaking order, which is taken on record. The Registry is directed to scan the same and make it part of the soft copy of the case.

3. The counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order, qua which contempt was asserted, has since been complied with by passing speaking order, whereby the representation of the petitioner has



been decided. No further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, the petitioner will be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
