The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in DDR No.27 dated 29.10.2024 under Sections 115(2), 118(1) and 118(2) of Bharatiya Nayaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023 (Section 118(2) added later-on on 10.02.2025) in case FIR No.291 dated 29.10.2024 under Sections 110, 333, 115(2), 351(2), 351(3) and 3(5) of Bharatiya Nayaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023 registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 04.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 04.03.2025 is **made absolute**. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
