Prayer in the present application moved on behalf of the  
applicant-respondent No. 9 is for placing on record compromise deed  
dated 07.03.2025 arrived at between the parties.

A-2.

**MAIN CASE**

Prayer in the application bearing **CM No. 2842-C of 2025**  
moved on behalf of the applicant-respondent No. 9 is for deciding the

appeal in the light of compromise dated 07.03.2025 having been arrived at between the parties.

[2] Notice of the aforesaid application to the non-applicants / appellants.

[3] Learned counsel for the non-applicants/appellants accepts notice of the application and admits the factum of compromise dated 07.03.2025 (Annexure A-2).

[4] It has been pointed out by the respective counsel(s) that though in the compromise deed dated 07.03.2025, the consideration was to be paid in terms of Cheque Nos. 778871 & 384513, drawn at Indian Bank and Punjab National Bank respectively, however, the same have now been returned back and in lieu thereof, two Demand Draft Nos. 743272 & 409168, both dated 11.03.2025, amounting to Rs.5,00,000/- each, drawn at Indian Bank and Punjab & Sind Bank respectively, have been handed over by the learned counsel for the applicant-respondent to the learned counsel representing the legal representatives of appellant-Kaushalya Devi (deceased), who were permitted to be impleaded on record to pursue the appeal vide order dated 28.11.2024 passed by this Court.

[5] Accordingly, in the light of compromise dated 07.03.2025 arrived at between the parties, learned counsel for the appellants does not press the present appeal any further.

[6] In view of the aforesaid development, present application bearing CM No. 2842-C of 2025 is **allowed** and the **main appeal** is hereby **dismissed as not pressed**, thereby upholding the judgment and decree dated 07.08.1999 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Rupnagar / Appellate Court.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
