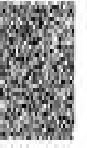
1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.119, dated 31.05.2023, under Sections 21 (b) and 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.

2. By virtue of order dated 13.09.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Navjagdeep Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
