Learned State counsel has brought to notice of this Court order dated 24.07.2025 passed by Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Punjab whereby, the petitioner(s) who were yet to attain the age of 60 years have been reinstated and those who have already completed the age of superannuation shall be released their revised terminal benefits.

In response, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that though, the reinstatement has been ordered, however, the same has been done on notional basis and arrears of salary have not been ordered to be released in favour of the petitioner(s). If so aggrieved, the petitioner(s) shall be at liberty to seek remedies as per law.

Once speaking order dated 24.07.2025 has been passed, the present petition is disposed of.
