PARMOD GOYAL, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner is aggrieved by order dated 19.08.2025 (Annexure P-30) passed by Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Nakodar vide which the application under Section 151 Civil Procedure Code, 1908 read with Section 114 and Order 47 Rule 1 Civil Procedure Code, 1908 for expunging observations made in order dated 02.07.2025 (Annexure P-27), was dismissed.

2. Perusal of impugned order dated 19.08.2025 (Annexure P-30) goes to show that learned Court has duly considered the fact that the observation made in order dated 02.07.2025 was in accordance with facts of the case and there is no clerical or typographical error in the same and, therefore, there was no reason to review order dated 02.07.2025 by expunging the observations as being sought by present petitioner-judgment debtor.

3. I find merit in the conclusion arrived at by learned Court below

vide impugned order dated 19.08.2025 (Annexure P-30). The order dated 02.07.2025 was passed on merits, though the learned counsel for petitioner has argued that it was made out of context, as actual application was for summoning the records and, therefore, there was no need or occasion to make observations passed by Court in order dated 02.07.2025.

4. Since, the Court has made observations in order dated 02.07.2025 consciously for the purposes of deciding said application, therefore, no review is justified or can be made by this Court. The only remedy available to the aggrieved party is to challenge the same either by way of an appeal or revision in accordance with law.

5. Therefore, no fault with the impugned order can be found. However, petitioner shall be free to take appropriate action in accordance with law, if so permitted as per law.

6. Civil Revision petition is disposed of.
