1. Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 of BNSS 2023, is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.129 dated 05.05.2024, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional (Regulation) Act, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, Punjab.

2. Status report dated 21.05.2025 by way of affidavit of PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Phillaur, Jalandhar (Rural), on behalf of respondent – State filed in Court today is taken on record.
