1. Present contempt petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for non-compliance of the order dated 14.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

2. Learned State counsel has submitted that in pursuance of the order dated 14.05.2025, the services of the petitioner have been regularized under 2011 policy and the pay of the petitioner for being considered under the Old Pension Scheme has also been approved. It is further submitted that the arrears on account of the same would be released to the petitioner within a period of three months from today. A copy of the order dated 25.09.2025, which has been passed by the

respondent authorities has been handed over to the Court and is taken on record and has been marked as “Mark A”.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the above, the present contempt petition be disposed of, but has prayed that the respondents be bound by the above-said statement made before this Court.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present contempt petition is disposed of, at this stage. The respondents would be bound by the statement made before this Court. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the present contempt petition in case the respondents back-track from the said statement.
