1. Prayer in this petition under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for wilful disobedience of the order dated 08.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP-4295-2025.
2. Learned State counsel submits that in deference to the order dated 08.05.2025, the representation made by the petitioner has been disposed of vide speaking order dated 30.07.2025. A copy of the said order has been produced in Court and also handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner having perused the aforesaid order dated 30.07.2025 submits that (supra) representation has been partly allowed to the extent that the jurisdiction of the arms license has been extended to the State of Haryana, but rejected for the State of Delhi citing non-submission of adequate justification under the Arms Rules, 2016.
