1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to prevent respondents No. 4 and 5 from threatening the petitioner with a further prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take legal action against the private respondents who have created a serious law and order situation.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, he will be satisfied if direction is issued to respondent No.3 for deciding his representation dated 28.05.2025 (Annexure P-2).

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Ishan Kaushal, AAG, Punjab, appears on advance notice and waives service on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 28.05.2025 (Annexure P-2), in accordance with

law, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. It is clarified that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the veracity of the allegations raised by the petitioner in his representation.
