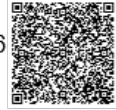

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.234 dated 18.7.2024 registered under Sections 109, 115(2), 126(2), 351(2), 351(3), 191(3), 190 of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar.

2. On the last date of hearing, it was brought to the notice of the Court that no doubt, the petitioner was member of unlawful assembly but only simple injuries caused with blunt weapon are attributed to the present petitioner. Resultantly, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join investigation with the police.

3. Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner apprised the Court that the petitioner has already joined investigation with the police in compliance of the aforesaid order.

4. Present petition is resisted by the State counsel as well as counsel for the complainant who submits that custodial interrogation of the present petitioner is required for purpose of proper investigation. State counsel on instructions from Inspector Mandeep Singh has not disputed the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation with the police and that only simple injuries caused with blunt weapon are ascribed to the present petitioner.

5. In view of the fact that only simple injuries that too caused with blunt weapon are attributed to the present petitioner and further the petitioner has already joined investigation with the police, no purpose is going to be served even if the petitioner is subjected to custodial interrogation at this point of time.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 22.11.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS. However, the petitioner is to join further investigation in the present case as and when called to do so by the investigating officer/SHO concerned.
