1. Petitioners – Bhupinder Singh, Malkiat Singh, Harjit Kaur, Harjinder Kaur and Kulwinder Kaur have filed this petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.123 dated 22.07.2023, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 of IPC 1860 at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1/T) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioners, in light of the compromise effected between the parties dated 05.02.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. As per order dated 07.05.2025, Ms. Rubi Khokhar, Advocate appeared on behalf of respondent No.2 who confirmed the compromise and the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqqa Magistrate on or before 26.05.2025 and the report was awaited for 18.07.2025.

3. Report has been received from learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar vide letter No.574 dated 11.06.2025, according to which the parties did not appear in the court for recording of their statements. On the previous date, learned counsel for petitioners as well as respondent No.2 were duly informed about the factual position. On their request, case was adjourned to today. Today, learned counsel for petitioners is again requesting for adjournment whereas nobody has turned up on behalf of respondent No.2.

4. From the aforesaid factual position, it is evident that petitioners and respondent No.2 failed to settle their dispute as per alleged compromise dated 05.02.2025 (Annexure P-2). Therefore, petition seeking quashing of aforesaid FIR (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise is accordingly declined. However, the parties are at liberty to seek appropriate remedy available to them as per law.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
