MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, *inter alia*, for quashing of impugned order dated 27.05.2019 (P-4), passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, vide which bail order has been cancelled and bail bonds/ surety bonds of the petitioner have been forfeited to the State.

(2) After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner on instructions submits that petitioner shall surrender before learned trial



Court within two weeks from today; however, his regular bail application be decided in some time bound manner.

- (3) Prayer seems to be justified and accepted.
- (4) Let the petitioner surrender before learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate within two weeks from today and in case he moves an application for regular bail, the same be considered and decided, expeditiously, in accordance with law.
- (5) Disposed off accordingly.
- (6) Needless to say that this order be not construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of controversy in any manner.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
