Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the respondents to re-issue the passport of petitioner, as applied by him vide File No.ARN:24-0012522756 dated 24.07.2024 (Annexure P-8); as no action has been taken thereupon till date despite representation dated 20.01.2025 (Annexure P-12) being filed before the Regional Passport Officer, Amritsar, in this regard.

2. Ms. Komal Preet Chauhan, Senior Panel Counsel, Union of India appears on behalf of the respondent/Union of India, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to her, and informs the Court that letter dated 23.09.2024 was issued to the petitioner by

the Regional Passport Office, Amritsar, whereby certain clarifications regarding issuance of passport facilities to the petitioner were to be addressed by him; however, the same has not been done so far.

2.1 Learned counsel for the respondent/Union of India has handed over a copy of the aforesaid letter dated 23.09.2024, issued by the Regional Passport Office, Amritsar, in Court today; which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. A copy thereof is also supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, in Court today itself.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Regional Passport Office, Amritsar and to respond to the aforesaid letter dated 23.09.2024, issued by the Regional Passport Office, Amritsar, by addressing all the clarifications, as mentioned therein.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
