**AMARJOT BHATTI, J.**

1. Petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.114 dated 28.05.2025 under Sections 137 (2)/96/3 (5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 registered at Police Station Sadar Bathinda, Punjab (Annexure P-1).

2. As per facts of the case 'BS' @ 'B' gave his statement that he got married about 17 years ago. Victim 'RK' is her elder daughter studying in 10<sup>th</sup> class in Shaheed Karam Singh Senior Secondary School, Naruana, Bathinda. On 26.05.2025 at about 7.45 am, she along with 'GK' had gone to their school on auto rickshaw. His daughters were alighted on the school gate. One of his daughter went inside the school but his elder daughter 'RK' was taken away by Sukhbir Sijngh and his friend Ranvir Singh @ Rana on their Splendor motorcycle. At about 8 am, when he was present at bus-stand



he saw motorcycle passed by his side at a high speed on which two young boys and a girl were sitting thereon with covered faces. On enquiry, he came to know that his daughter did not attend her school on that day. He is having full suspicion that the victim has been taken away by Sukhbir Singh and his friend Ranvir Singh @ Rana by giving allurements of marriage.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that in pursuance of order dated 24.07.2025 he has joined the investigation. Allegations of rape are not against him. Main accused is namely Sukhbir Singh and it is claimed that he assisted Sukhbir Singh in taking away the victim. Petitioner is ready to abide by the terms of bail order. Therefore, his anticipatory bail petition may be allowed.

4. Detailed status report filed and the same is taken on record. Learned counsel representing State pointed out that during the investigation of this case, victim was recovered in the company of accused Sukhbir Singh. Victim was medically examined on 29.05.2025 and her statement was also recorded under Section 183 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 which is Annexure R1/T and copy of MLR is Annexure R-2.

In pursuance of order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation on 29.07.2025 and Hero Splendor motorcycle bearing No.PB-03BP-0162 is also taken into police possession. It is confirmed that petitioner is not required for further investigation.

5. I have considered the aforesaid factual position. As referred above, there are allegations against the present petitioner that he assisted co-accused Sukhbir Singh in taking away the victim on motorcycle. Petitioner has joined investigation and fully cooperated with the investigating agency.



Alleged motorcycle is taken into police possession and he is not required for any other purpose. Considering the aforesaid factual position, anticipatory bail petition filed by petitioner is allowed. He be not arrested. In case of his arrest, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer concerned, subject to condition that petitioner will join investigation as and when required. He will not tamper with or interfere with investigation and will not leave country without prior permission as provided under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
