In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that the petitioners are entitled for revision of their pension by talking into account the multiplier factor of 2.59 on the basic pay admissible to the post from which the petitioners retired w.e.f. 01.01.2016 alongwith consequential benefits etc.

2. From the pleadings, it is clear that the petitioners have already raised the same grievance in the legal notice dated 18.08.2024 (Annexure P-11), and the interest of justice would be served, at this stage, that the respondents be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Aditya Sharda, DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State

and submits that in case, any representation/legal notice, has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of 08 weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

5. Keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, no further order is required to be passed.
6. Present petition is disposed off accordingly.
