1. Prayer made in the present case is for quashing the action of the respondents in not considering and granting the benefit of regularization of services of the petitioners after completion of 10 years, in terms of law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in **Jaggo vs. Union of India**, 2025(1) SLR 1 and Civil Appeal No.8157 of 2024, **Shripal and another vs. Nagar Nigam, Gaziabad**, decided on 31.01.2025, with regard to which learned counsel for the petitioners would submit a detailed representation, which may be directed to be decided, in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.

2. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case, the petitioners submit the representation

within a period of 4 weeks, the same shall be decided within a period of 04 months thereafter, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
