1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to issue directions to the official respondents not to harass the petitioners by conducting multiple enquiries at the instance of the complainant in the present case.

2. Reply by way of an affidavit of Jayant Puri IPS, ASP, Sub Division City-I, District SAS Nagar has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State and the same is taken on record.
