1. Present Contempt Petition has been filed under Sections 11/ 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for summoning the respondents, proceeding against them and for punishing them on account of their violating the order dated 19.10.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court.
2. Learned State counsel has referred to the order dated 23.05.2025, the relevant portion of which is reproduced hereinbelow:-

*“Further, it is mention here that the payment of pension arrear of Rs. 42,59,329/(38,12,765 + 4,46,564) revised Death - Cum- Retirement Gratuity payment of Rs. 2,85,721/- (2,55,765 + 29,956) alongwith 9% interest from 01.02.2024 till the date of the payment credited to Sh. V.B. Abrol, Lecturer (retired on 30.11.2006) from Dyal Singh College, Karnal and the payment has been made subject to final outcome of decision of appeal which is being filed by the department.*

*In view of submissions made above, it is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the orders dated 16.05.2025 fully complied and you are requested to apprised above said facts to*



*this Hon'ble High Court and request to the Hon'ble High Court that the present contempt petition may kindly be dismissed in the interest of justice. The case is fixed for hearing on 26.05.2025."*

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the abovesaid amount alongwith interest as stated therein has been released.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the pension of the petitioner has not been properly calculated and there is still amount due to the petitioner and has submitted that the present petition be disposed of but liberty be granted to the petitioner to institute appropriate proceedings to claim the said amount.

5. In view of the above, present Contempt Petition is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
