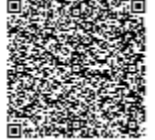
1. By way of filing the instant contempt petition, the petitioner has alleged intentional and willfull disobedience of the order dated 19.03.2025, passed in CWP-7432-2025 (Annexure P-1), by the respondent, whereby, following order was passed:-

5. *Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director General, Transport Department, Haryana, to decide the representations dated 18.02.2025 and 25.02.2025 (Annexures P-11 to 13) submitted by the petitioners and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, if prescribed under law.*
