RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 21.02.2024 passed by this court in CWP-3917-2024.

2. The order, qua which the contempt is alleged, is of the nature which involves adjudication of several disputed questions of fact to assess whether it has been violated or not. However, contempt proceedings are not to be used to adjudicate upon the disputed questions of facts between the parties. Hence, this court does not find it appropriate to initiate any contempt proceedings in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

3. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, he will be at liberty to avail any other remedy, but in accordance with law.
