The present petition under Section 528 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been preferred by the petitioner seeking direction to official respondents to conduct a proper and fair investigation in FIR No.184 dated 02.10.2024 registered under Section 115(2), 304, 3(5) Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1).

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner being the complainant of the case had moved a representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur for conducting fair investigation in the case FIR (Annexure P-1), but till date no action thereon has been taken. He submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if directions are given to respondent No.3-Senior



Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to consider and dispose of the representation dated 17.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Singh Bhatta, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.

5. After considering the respective submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to consider and dispose of the representation dated 17.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner as well.
